Meeting Notes:

- Ed Vardon suggested buoys be placed selectively at 200 feet from shore to help guide boaters on judging proper interval from shore. Discussion continued that DNR must approve buoy placement and these are difficult to obtain.
- Bill Hass discussed amendments to the 20 pages of the Comprehensive Recreational Plan suggested and approved by the steering committee. It will be presented to The Village Board for action ASAP. In addition, carrying capacity was reviewed and committee members asked to continue to perform boat counts on the forms provided, especially on weekends. It was noted that: the Lake Ripley report while data intensive, is not as broad and insightful as the comprehensive recreational plan drafted by the committee. Also, it does not reflect the high degree of remediation actions which were planned and budgeted for grants in the Committee reports at the annual Twin Lakes Lake District meeting
- Ed Vardon suggested the village board delegate to the committee the ability to mediate conflicts between user groups. He will make the appeal at the next opportunity.
