**Meeting Notes:**

- A. Randy Prudic spoke on Pier and raft regulations. Village asked for voluntary compliance this year but got little compliance.
- Any pier requiring a DNR permit that does not have one will be hauled out by TL Police.
- Residents are asked to apply early and obtain a Sticker before putting in pier
- About 20-27 violators were informed.
- There was significant discussion of what represents a violation.
- All permits and applications need to go to the chief of police
- Need for lifeguard at Lance Park was discussed.
- Voluntary compliance for street number labeling of piers is encouraged. A letter was sent by the village suggesting 3 inch high letters.
- Tom Porps presented the comprehensive plan to the steering committee and it was approved.
- Tom Porps will pursue how "Town Hall" Meeting format of the lake district meeting should be run in view of the current controversy on mandates and as described in Gerry Wrench letter.
- The budget passed.
- The form of the comprehensive plan submitted to the village was discussed. It was not submitted with full copies of the committee slides so we may need to resubmit with a more complete copy of committee plans.
