Old Business:

Corinne reported that several of the Association out-reach letters were returned to sender, but that this should not be discouraging as one Association contacted her to attend their Annual Meeting. Due to short notice, Corinne attended and talked to the association members about Lake District topics and potential projects. She felt the meeting went well but ask that a protocol for answering a request be established. Members felt a simple email to the group would be best for handling any future requests. Pam volunteered to look into the appropriate contact person for each of the returned letter and try to reach any Associations that did not receive the letter. The committee then previewed a slide show of the photo reel with a special section dedicated to the new Lake Elizabeth public access site! Pam called for a working meeting to complete the photo reel at her home on the 16th of June at 9AM. Members could attend as they had time to work on completing the project. Corinne requested a tile be added for the new Sand Beach Ordinance and recommended changing the photos so there were not so many repeats from last years photo reel. Corinne also asked that the year-end Presentation start being put together for review at the July meeting. Pam volunteered to contact all the committee leaders requesting a synopsis of their activities throughout the year. Finally, the committee discussed the member pins Mary had been working on. She stated that the committee was definitely cutting it close to have the pins ready in time for the Annual Meeting, but if a decision could be made as to how many the vendor would begin working on a proof from the committee design concept. Members talked briefly about color, text, shape, and style. Mary agreed to take the information back to her contact and would email the committee for further guidance. The committee members agreed to finalize any details of the event outside a formal meeting due to timing.
