

Communication, Education, Youth Committee 6/23/2006 Minutes

Called to order by Vicki Skinner acting chairperson for Corinne Krebs at 5:30 pm.

Members in Attendance: Vicki Skinner, Mary Wolaver, John Wolaver, Pam Becker, and Corinne Krebs

Members not in Attendance: Lynne Hellman

The committee had no discussion on the "Food for Thought" statement. No meeting minutes were read or approved.

The committee began the meeting by discussing member reports. Vicki Skinner began by presenting the data sheets provided for boat counts on the lakes. Overall, members felt the sheet was sufficient, but recommended the word "on" be removed from each line as it's unnecessary. Vicki then presented a form she had been working on for data collection. After some discussion, she felt she had a better understanding and idea for the sheets and would like to bring back a new format for committee review. All other members present had nothing to report to the committee.

For New Business, the committee focused on the rapidly approaching Annual Lake District Meeting. Corinne presented last year's survey and feedback sheets. She asked for opinions concerning the form. John suggested the forms be used as raffle for donated items from local businesses. The committee agreed that if raffle prizes were secured, individuals filling out forms would qualify and a raffle would take place.

Corinne presented past PowerPoint presentations and talked about the multimedia presentation. The committee agreed that fewer words and more photos would make the presentation more interesting. The 2005-2006 Committee Reviews would be done in that format and be printed as handouts for the people in attendance. All members present liked the multimedia show last year and felt another one similar to it should be put together for the upcoming meeting. Discussion about past meetings led to an interesting proposition for the production of Lake District Committee Member T-Shirts. The District would purchase one shirt for each of the committee members to wear at the meeting so that they could be identified by people who are unfamiliar with all the committee members. Committee members felt that this would promote mingling between Committee members and attendees thus facilitating new volunteer enrollment, as well as greater understanding of lake issues.

Motion: To purchase T-shirts for all committee members to read "Lake District Committee Member" identifying all volunteers at the Annual Meeting.
