Meeting Notes

We decided to continue with discussion of our projects even though we did not have a quorum to conduct business.

Judy Jooss will take notes. Michael Lux submitted his notes from the September meeting. They will be combined with the draft notes Judy distributed at the tour and tonight. They will be submitted to the committee for approval in November.

We reviewed the photos of the tour sites and discussed what we thought should be our priorities. A new site was added after the committee's tour; it is the fire lane on South Lake Avenue across from and north of the Beach Bar property. The other sites are listed below.

- Lance Park (Village) – beach & possible fishing pier site
- Pawley site (Village) - possible fishing pier site, culvert research, future landscaping
- Bay View channel (homeowner association) – wetland & bank stabilization, future dredging project, stormwater control issues
- Hickory Point beach (Village & neighborhood association) – improve site, stop sand erosion
- Lakeview channel (4) (Village) – landscape, possible fishing pier site
- LEM beach site (Village) – improve site, stop sand erosion

It was the consensus of those present that our priority projects should be the fire lane on South Lake because of its high visibility and the grading, landscaping, and installation of a fishing pier at the intersection of Haerle and the Lakeview channel on the south side. Judy will research ownership and contact the Village and Fire Department about fire lane use and lake access in the channel.

The Bay View Channel project will be a complex long term project involving shoreline stabilization with natural vegetation, control of stormwater pollutant loading to the channel, and eventual dredging of the stabilized channel. Andy Hryniewicz will act as the committee's team leader for this project. He will be contacting Craig Helker of the WDNR and consultant Kathy Aron to visit a similar project they just completed on Eagle Lake.

Judy & Bob Livingston toured the sites on Friday, October 31, 2003 and discussed at length the Lance Park situation. They will work together with the Village, the DNR, and the Aquanuts to design a more lake friendly show site for the After The Fact Permit that the DNR is requiring the Village to obtain for the work already completed and that planned for the remainder of the show area.

The other projects in our list will be brought online as time & resources allow.

The committee meetings will return to their regular schedule of the 3rd Thursday every month beginning on November 20, 2003.
