

Twin Lakes Protection & Rehabilitation District Steering Council Meeting Minutes

No meeting minutes were read or approved.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Corinne Krebs reported that two members of the community have expressed an interest in joining the Communication Committee. She will be meeting with them and scheduling meetings again soon. Some discussion about getting volunteers from other committees to join the Communication Committee followed but concluded shortly due to having enough members to fill out the committee and desire of the other members to remain on their existing committees.

Tom Porps reported on his Boat Safety & User Conflict Committee progress with public property inventory (POPS). The committee felt some format adjustments needed to be made so the context of each parcel would be clearer. They also recommended the parcel be highlighted on the topographic map and on the orthographic photo that on the parcel focused on be outlined instead of all parcels. Corinne suggested a date be added to all maps for information accuracy purposes. Finally, Tom addressed concerns about Current, Historic, and Possible Future Uses listed for the parcel. He felt the committee would need more time to go through each parcel to address possible future use. The Council agreed and asked the committee to continue pursuing completion as soon as possible.

OLD BUSINESS

While Tom had the floor, the Council proceeded into old Business addressing the estimated cost of printing the Courtesy Code Sticker to be handed out this season. Badgerland, a local printing firm, provided reasonable prices along with a "friendly discount". The Council agreed to make 3000 copies to be distributed by the Lake District, local Bait Shop, the police department, Volunteers, the Chamber of Commerce, and anyone else willing to participate. A motion was made to accept Badgerland's proposal for the stickers and proceed with the printing.

NEW BUSINESS

Tom was then asked to speak about his concerns with the Shoreline Zoning Ordinance. Tom sits on the Twin Lakes Variance Board and believes the Shoreline Ordinance put in place last year conflicts with existing ordinances. He felt some of the language needed to be changed to

avoid an overwhelming number of variances coming through the Village. The goal being, to reduce the number of non-conforming structures in the Village. Other Council members present felt they needed more education on other ordinances set forth in the Village and asked that Tom make the changes he felt necessary to avoid the conflict. The Council will address the issue again at the next meeting.

When Tom finally stopped talking, The Council reviewed a proposal from BioAquatic Services for chemical treatment of aquatic weeds. All members present felt they understood the proposal without further explanation from Tony and a motion was made to approve the proposal for aquatic weed treatment by BioAquatic Services.
